Unit 1 includes government agencies and committees such as the Agency for Economic Analyses and Forecasting, Agency for Privatization of Government and Municipal Property, Commission for Protection of Competition, High Certifying Commission, Main Administration-Archives, Main Administration - Economics of Defense and National Reserves, National Intelligence Service, National Statistical Institute, Agency for Foreign Investments, Central Administration of Road Construction, Patent Agency.

Unit 2 includes Chief Prosecutor's office, High Judicial Council, Ministry of Justice, Supreme Court, Supreme Government Arbitration.

Unit 3 comprises the following extra-budgetary funds and accounts: Professional Qualification and Unemployment Fund, National Fund for Environment Protection, National Fund for Road Network, Fund for Development of the Air Traffic Service National System, Rehabilitation and Social Integration Fund, National Donation Fund, National Housing Compensation Fund, Radio and Television Fund, Housing Construction Fund, Fund for Financing the Concession Expenditures, Fund for Financing the Public Enterprises Privatization Expenditures, Fund for Safety and Storage of Radioactive Waste products, Fund for Bringing out Nuclear Equipment Exploitation, Agricultural Fund, Extra-budgetary Account for the National Assembly State Gazette, Extra-budgetary Account for Compensation of Former Dwelling's owners and users.

Unit 4 includes Pension Fund, Labor Handicap and Professional Disease Fund, General Disease and Maternity Fund, Health Insurance Fund, Fund for Professional Qualification and Unemployment.

Data in local government tables cover operations of unit 5.
